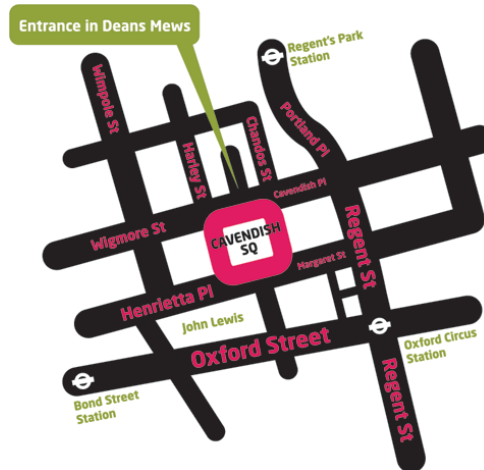
Message from the Honorary Secretary, Dr Rachel Pollard

Winter Meeting 2010 - Topic Information

The APA guidelines for Outpatient paediatric Exodontia have now been presented at the APA meeting in Glasgow in May 2010 by Dr Lola Adewale. She will be presenting them at our ADA meeting. Following this there will be a debate about intravenous cannulation of children undergoing dental extractions- IV or not IV?

The past year has been focussed on children's dental work- the next topic on the agenda will be Dr Sury, Paediatric Anaesthetist from Great Ormond Street. He will be presenting the NICE guidelines for sedation for children. They will just have been released in November. The discussion

will include whether these guidelines should apply to dental sedation for children, which is out of hospital, in contrast with most paediatric sedation procedures.

Lastly our final session will be related to the growing problem of obesity related to dental work.

How do we manage patients with sleep apnoea for sedation or anaesthesia for dental work?

How do we manage patients who are obese for sedation and anaesthesia for dental work?
